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TS to form high-level panel to study issue of broken rice

After Centre's nod, FCI norms on raw rice procurement put government in a fix

WITH the Centre giving approval to the State government's intent to deliver 40.20 lakh tonnes of raw rice in Rabi 2021-22 marketing season, clouds of uncertainty over paddy procurement have been cleared.

However, ambiguity remains over how the State government intends to make up for the shortfall in delivering raw rice as per the regulations of Food Corporation of India, as the issue of 'high quantity of broken rice during milling' as being claimed by the State government, is still a matter of concern.

According to the agriculture department, 83.83 lakh tonnes of paddy is expected to be produced in Rabi

season. Of this, 60 lakh tonnes would be procured. Under normal conditions, 40 lakh tonnes of raw rice is expected after milling, however, millers have been claiming otherwise.

According to Thota Sampath, President of Warangal Rice Millers' Association, in 10-12 districts of

Telangana, half of the output comes out as broken rice, and in 13-14 districts rice becomes powdery while milling. He told Express that in many parts of erstwhile Karimnagar, Medak and Warangal districts, only 34-35 kg head rice (proper rice) comes out after

milling. As per FCI's norms, for every 100 kg paddy, 67 kg raw rice needs to be delivered to it. There is a flexibility of delivering 25 per cent of this 67 kg, which comes to 16.75 kg, as broken rice. The remaining 50.25 kg has to be head rice.

According to Dr R Vijaya Kumari, Principal Investigator, Market Intelligence Centre at PJTSAU, while the outturn ratio of paddy in kharif season is between 64 per cent to 66 per cent (the quantity of rice obtained per quintal paddy while milling), it is 50 to 60 per cent in Rabi season.

The State government would constitute a high-level committee with IAS officers to study the issue of broken rice and how to make up for the shortfall in raw rice deliverable to FCI. "It is not just the temperature factor which determines how much rice would come out as broken rice. We need to look at the size and capacity of rice mills and milling efficiency," Dr Vijaya Kumari opined.
